

FROM THE PRESIDENT:

We had a good meeting in October with Bill Henry, President of ASCE National in attendance. Bill talked about several key issues that are occurring at the national level of ASCE including engineering education, Policy 465 on future requirements for P.E. registration and Global Principles for Professional Conduct. A total of 50 members and students were in attendance.

An Order of the Engineer Ceremony was held for those who qualified. We had 23 members take the Oath of the Order of the Engineer, giving their promise to conduct themselves in an ethical and professional manner when acting as a Civil Engineer doing business with the public. Bill Henry and Jeff Dixon presented the Honors.

The Annual Meeting in Baltimore was a great success! There were several good technical sessions to attend on Transportation, Structural Engineering, Leadership & Management, Water & Wastewater, Hydrology & Hydraulics just to mention a few. The ASCE Headquarters Orientation Meeting after the conference had a wealth of information on what ASCE is doing to promote Civil Engineers. The new Governance structure will re-

duce the size of the National Board of Direction from 28 members to 17 members. Two Institutional Members will serve on the Board which are new positions. Oklahoma, Texas and New Mexico will become Region 6. Previously, this was District 15 and was part of the larger Zone III area encompassing much of the Midwest and Great Lake States.

The educational programs that have been developed for all ages of students K-12 will help to assure that we have future Civil Engineers to fill the gap as many current Civil Engineers retire. One of the more interesting programs is the West Point Bridge Design Contest (<http://bridgecontest.usma.edu>), a nationwide Internet-based competition intended to provide middle and high school students with a realistic, engaging introduction to engineering. This program can be presented to any middle or high school easily and is free of charge. Local competitions can also be held between schools in the same area. Scholarships are issued to members of the top two teams nationally and laptop computers are given for each member of the top five teams.

The Annual "Fly In" Legislative Day in Washington, D.C. will happen again next year in March. Any ASCE member is welcome to attend. You can also contact your legislator through the ASCE 6-Clicks program which is part of the ASCE website (www.asce.org). If you haven't visited the website lately, there are many things that you are not taking advantage of through ASCE. ASCE continues to monitor legislation at the national and state levels to assure that ASCE's membership (137,000) are informed about any legislation that may affect their profession.

The Oklahoma Section had a Board Meeting in October to continue our discussion on some of the goals of the Section and Branches this year. One of the major goals is to increase membership and participation by members in the Branches and Section. We would also like to provide to the membership, quality professional workshops and training to assist in developing our profession and providing educational credits for Professional Engineering renewals. We have promoted an increased involvement with the Universities by utilizing our Young Members Forum. Josh Dougherty and Kristi Bellatti continue to meet with our student members presenting them with current topics in civil engineering. Our student attendance has continued to grow at the Branch meetings.
